Licensed since 1729, this Grade II Listed pub is on CAMRA's National Inventory. Two bars full of character. It lies on medieval cobbled High Street.

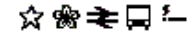

Refurbished Sam Smith's tied house in the centre of town. A single roomed pub, but manages to have four distinctive areas. Two real fires have been reinstated.

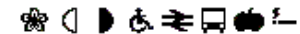
